

“SPIN TO WIN DOUGH” OFFICIAL RULES

1. How to Enter:

The WLDE Spin to Win Dough Contest will begin Thursday, October 19, 2023, at 6:00am, and end on November 10, 2023, at 9:00am.

No purchase necessary.

To participate, listen each weekday between 6:00am and 9:00am during the contest period. A WLDE personality will play the “Spin to Win Dough” prize wheel sound effect and announce the amount of money associated with that episode’s giveaway. Once the amount is revealed WLDE will solicit the 10th caller at (260)-426-5343 and the correct caller will win the designated amount ranging from \$50 to \$500 dollars. Prize amounts may vary with each contest episode and are predetermined prior to contest play.

WLDE will award the money after the 10th caller meets all eligibility restrictions.

If the 10th caller does not meet eligibility restrictions, the next caller will be taken until the money is awarded. If no money is awarded, it will remain the property of WLDE.

Once a WLDE personality solicits the 10th caller during contest play, listeners to WLDE have 10 minutes to be the 10th caller. If a 10th caller is not received, no money is awarded.

WLDE will play the Spin to Win Dough contest twice each weekday during the contest period.

Portions of the Spin to Win Dough prize wheel sound effects that are featured in commercials, promos, sound bites, news clips or the Birthday Wheel contest are not eligible for this contest.

2. Eligibility Restrictions:

The Spin to Win Dough Contest is open to legal residents 18 years of age and older and who reside in the WLDE, Classic Hits 101.7 listening area including the following counties: Allen, Adams, Dekalb, Whitley, Wells, Noble, Steuben, Huntington in Indiana, and Defiance, Van Wert and Paulding counties in Ohio. The winners may be required to sign an Affidavit of Eligibility and a Receipt for Prize and Award upon acceptance of the prize.

Pursuant to the above-mentioned paperwork, the winners will agree to hold WLDE, Sarkes Tarzian, Inc., and the respective officers, shareholders, directors, employees, agents, and representatives of each of them harmless from and against any and all claims or liability arising directly or indirectly from the prize or participation in the Spin to Win Dough Contest.
